B. ADMISSION AND GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS FOR SENIOR COLLEGE PROGRAM

(e.g., minimum GPA, audition/portfolio):

LaGuardia Community College graduates with the Associate Degree in Science, Music Performance will receive 60 credits toward the Bachelor of Music, Music Performance at Brooklyn College.

Associate of Science Degree Graduates of CUNY Colleges are exempt from all Required Core, Flexible Core, and Foreign Language Component of the General Education requirements. To earn a Bachelor's Degree at Brooklyn College, CUNY Associate Degree graduates need to:

- complete at minimum 50% of the courses required for the major and minor (if applicable) in residence
- two upper-level interdisciplinary courses chosen under advisement
- two writing intensive courses
- elective courses, if needed.

Total transfer credits granted toward the baccalaureate degree: 60

Total additional credits required at the senior college to complete baccalaureate degree: 60

E. Articulation Agreement Follow-Up Procedures

1. Procedures for reviewing, up-dating, modifying or terminating agreement:

This agreement will be reviewed annually by department chairs at both LaGuardia Community College and Brooklyn College and all relevant changes will be made as an amendment to this agreement. This agreement may be terminated at any time by either party.

2. Procedures for evaluating agreement, e.g., tracking the number of students who transfer under the articulation agreement and their success:

Brooklyn College will inform LaGuardia Community College about the academic progress of transfer students.

3. Sending and receiving college procedures for publicizing agreement, e.g., college catalogs, transfer Advisors, Websites, etc.:


Notice of articulation will be placed in the respective catalogues, recruiting brochures, and websites.

Respective transfer and academic advisors will be informed and provided with copies of this agreement.


The Brooklyn College Enrollment Services division will attend recruiting events on-campus at LaGuardia Community College regularly.
