





1962

1968

Shirley Chisholm '46, becomes the first African American woman elected to US Congress.

1983

Stanley Cohen '43 and Rita Levi-Montalcini become Nobel Prize Laureates in Physiology or Medicine for their work with growth factors.

2015

The Feirstein Graduate School of Cinema opens. It is the only public graduate film school in the United States located on a working film lot.
