Description of Identified Risk Factors	 Factors that might place an employee at risk include but are not limited to: Offices that handle the exchange of money, including cash, checks, money orders, and credit card receipts: Enrollment Services Center, Performing Arts Center, and Central Routing Mail Room. Offices that handle issues stressful to students, such as the Counseling Center, Enrollment Services Center, Academic Advising Offices, Office of Services for Students with Disabilities, Office of the Deans, Library and Library Café. Offices that handle issues stressful to faculty and staff, such as the Office of Human Resources. Work sites containing employees who work alone or in small groups: academic offices, faculty offices, entire campus for custodial staff, media technicians, IT support. Work sites containing employees who work late at night or early in the morning or on weekends; Entire campus for custodial staff and Public Safety staff, Library faculty and staff, faculty.
