As of the most recent available data (**November 07, 2022**), **9.1% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **8.6% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **65.5% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **63.1% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**November 07, 2022**), **12.3% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **5.5% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **79.8% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **80.4% fewer** credits.
