As of the most recent available data (**November 09, 2022**), **14.9% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **14.9% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **61.6% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **59.3% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**November 09, 2022**), **14.9% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **28.6% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **77.1% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **77.4% fewer** credits.
