As of the most recent available data (**November 10, 2022**), **15.6% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **15.0% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **59.9% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **57.6% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**November 10, 2022**), **29.2% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **39.9% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **75.8% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **76.0% fewer** credits.
