As of the most recent available data (**November 11, 2022**), 23.7% fewer undergraduates have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 22.9% fewer credits than they were at this time last year. There are 55.5% fewer undergraduates enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes 53.0% fewer credits.

As of the most recent available data (**November 11, 2022**), **39.6% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **47.6% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **74.9% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **74.9% fewer** credits.
