As of the most recent available data (November 14, 2022), 13.2% fewer undergraduates have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 14.0% fewer credits than they were at this time last year. There are 49.3% fewer undergraduates enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes 47.5% fewer credits.

As of the most recent available data (**November 14, 2022**), **25.1% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **35.1% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **68.9% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **68.9% fewer** credits.
