As of the most recent available data (**November 16, 2022**), **12.8% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **13.0% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **40.3% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **38.8% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**November 16, 2022**), **26.1% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **35.8% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **66.0% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **66.3% fewer** credits.
