As of the most recent available data (**November 17, 2022**), **14.2% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **15.6% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **38.0% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **36.9% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**November 17, 2022**), **26.9% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **36.3% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **65.6% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **65.9% fewer** credits.
