As of the most recent available data (**November 18, 2022**), **13.0% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **14.9% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **34.8% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **33.8% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**November 18, 2022**), **25.1% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **34.2% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **63.6% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **63.3% fewer** credits.
