As of the most recent available data (**November 25, 2022**), **13.1% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **14.7% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **29.9% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **28.9% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**November 25, 2022**), **26.5% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **34.7% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **61.1% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **60.5% fewer** credits.
