As of the most recent available data (**November 28, 2022**), **12.9% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **14.7% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **28.7% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **27.8% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**November 28, 2022**), **23.2% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **32.0% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **58.9% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **58.3% fewer** credits.
