As of the most recent available data (**December 05, 2022**), **12.2% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **13.8% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **22.7% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **22.1% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 05, 2022**), **5.2% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **15.7% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **43.1% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **43.0% fewer** credits.
