As of the most recent available data (**December 08, 2022**), **12.0% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **13.5% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **20.0% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **19.3% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 08, 2022**), **12.7% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **21.0% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **37.6% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **38.2% fewer** credits.
