As of the most recent available data (**December 09, 2022**), **12.7% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **14.0% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **19.3% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **18.6% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 09, 2022**), **11.9% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **20.4% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **35.6% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **36.8% fewer** credits.
