As of the most recent available data (**December 12, 2022**), **12.6% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **13.9% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **18.6% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **18.0% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 12, 2022**), **11.1% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **20.1% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **34.0% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **35.5% fewer** credits.
