As of the most recent available data (**December 13, 2022**), **12.9% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **14.1% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **18.1% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **17.3% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 13, 2022**), **8.6% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **17.5% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **31.3% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **32.8% fewer** credits.
