As of the most recent available data (**December 14, 2022**), **18.3% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **19.9% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **22.9% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **22.4% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 14, 2022**), **14.6% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **22.7% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **35.1% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **36.4% fewer** credits.
