As of the most recent available data (**December 15, 2022**), **15.0% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **16.3% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **19.5% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **18.7% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 15, 2022**), **12.3% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **20.6% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **32.0% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **33.8% fewer** credits.
