As of the most recent available data (**December 16, 2022**), **17.2% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **18.5% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **18.8% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **18.1% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 16, 2022**), **11.8% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **20.4% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **28.7% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **30.9% fewer** credits.
