As of the most recent available data (**December 19, 2022**), **15.2% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **17.1% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **16.8% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **16.7% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 19, 2022**), **10.4% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **19.5% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **27.6% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **30.1% fewer** credits.
