As of the most recent available data (**December 20, 2022**), **14.7% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **16.3% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **16.4% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **15.9% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 20, 2022**), **9.9% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **19.1% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **27.1% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **29.7% fewer** credits.
