As of the most recent available data (**December 21, 2022**), **14.4% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **15.9% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **16.1% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **15.5% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 21, 2022**), **9.1% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **18.1% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **26.4% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **28.9% fewer** credits.
