As of the most recent available data (**December 26, 2022**), **13.9% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **15.3% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **15.0% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **14.1% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 26, 2022**), **16.1% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **23.8% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **25.8% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **28.3% fewer** credits.
