As of the most recent available data (**December 27, 2022**), **13.5% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **15.3% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **14.3% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **13.7% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 27, 2022**), **19.2% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **26.2% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **26.0% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **28.4% fewer** credits.
