As of the most recent available data (**December 28, 2022**), **13.8% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **15.8% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **13.8% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **13.3% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 28, 2022**), **19.2% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **26.3% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **25.1% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **27.5% fewer** credits.
