As of the most recent available data (January 02, 2023), 11.8% fewer undergraduates have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 14.6% fewer credits than they were at this time last year. There are 13.7% fewer undergraduates enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes 13.4% fewer credits.

As of the most recent available data (January 02, 2023), 15.9% fewer graduate students have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 19.2% fewer credits than they were at this time last year. There are 18.0% fewer graduate students enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes 19.2% fewer credits.
