As of the most recent available data (January 03, 2023), 11.1% fewer undergraduates have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 13.7% fewer credits than they were at this time last year. There are 13.4% fewer undergraduates enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes 13.0% fewer credits.

As of the most recent available data (January 03, 2023), 14.1% fewer graduate students have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 16.8% fewer credits than they were at this time last year. There are 16.2% fewer graduate students enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes 17.1% fewer credits.
