As of the most recent available data (**January 04, 2023**), **10.9% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **13.7% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **14.0% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **13.7% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**January 04, 2023**), **14.4% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **17.2% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **16.4% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **17.3% fewer** credits.
