As of the most recent available data (**January 06, 2023**), **11.4% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **13.9% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **14.7% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **14.2% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**January 06, 2023**), **14.1% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **16.7% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **15.8% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **16.9% fewer** credits.
