As of the most recent available data (**January 10, 2023**), **11.2% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **13.7% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **14.6% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **14.1% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**January 10, 2023**), **14.0% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **16.5% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **15.6% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **16.5% fewer** credits.
