As of the most recent available data (November 15, 2024), 6.3% fewer undergraduates have enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2024 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 9.8% fewer credits than they were at this time last year. There are 23.6% fewer undergraduates enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2024 January Intersession, and this constitutes 24.9% fewer credits.

As of the most recent available data (November 15, 2024), 23.3% fewer graduate students have enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2024 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 22.8% fewer credits than they were at this time last year. There are 51.6% fewer graduate students enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2024 January Intersession, and this constitutes 49.6% fewer credits.
