As of the most recent available data (November 21, 2024), 4.9% fewer undergraduates have enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2024 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 8.1% fewer credits than they were at this time last year. There are 18.3% fewer undergraduates enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2024 January Intersession, and this constitutes 19.4% fewer credits.

As of the most recent available data (November 21, 2024), 5.3% fewer graduate students have enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2024 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 5.3% fewer credits than they were at this time last year. There are 37.0% fewer graduate students enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2024 January Intersession, and this constitutes 35.1% fewer credits.
