As of the most recent available data (**November 26, 2024**), **4.4% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2024 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **7.7% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **14.9% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2024 January Intersession, and this constitutes **16.5% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**November 26, 2024**), **28.7% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2024 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **23.0% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **12.2% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2024 January Intersession, and this constitutes **13.3% fewer** credits.
