As of the most recent available data (**December 04, 2024**), **2.7% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2024 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **0.6% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **8.5% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2024 January Intersession, and this constitutes **10.1% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 04, 2024**), **41.0% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2024 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **34.9% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **3.8% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2024 January Intersession, and this constitutes **4.9% fewer** credits.
