As of the most recent available data (**December 06, 2024**), **3.6% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2024 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **0.2% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **7.8% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2024 January Intersession, and this constitutes **9.3% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 06, 2024**), **42.6% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2024 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **37.2% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **2.7% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2024 January Intersession, and this constitutes **3.3% fewer** credits.
