As of the most recent available data (**December 11, 2024**), **3.5% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2024 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **6.8% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **10.2% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2024 January Intersession, and this constitutes **12.0% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 11, 2024**), 27.4% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2024 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 24.9% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 0.3% fewer graduate students enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2024 January Intersession, and this constitutes 0.5% fewer credits.
