As of the most recent available data (**December 17, 2024**), **1.4% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2024 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **5.1% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **6.4% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2024 January Intersession, and this constitutes **8.3% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 17, 2024**), 29.7% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2024 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 27.0% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 5.7% more graduate students enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2024 January Intersession, and this constitutes 5.9% more credits.
