As of the most recent available data (**December 19, 2024**), **1.4% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2024 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **5.6% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **5.5% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2024 January Intersession, and this constitutes **7.7% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 19, 2024**), **30.7% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2024 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **27.5% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **8.7% more** graduate students enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2024 January Intersession, and this constitutes **8.5% more** credits.
