As of the most recent available data (**December 20, 2024**), **1.7% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2024 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **5.5% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **5.0% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2024 January Intersession, and this constitutes **6.8% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 20, 2024**), **34.6% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2024 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **32.0% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **13.0% more** graduate students enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2024 January Intersession, and this constitutes **13.3% more** credits.
