As of the most recent available data (**December 26, 2024**), **2.4% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking the 2024 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking the 2025 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2024 January Intersession, and this constitutes **5.6% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 26, 2024**), **29.6% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2024 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **27.7% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **14.1% more** graduate students enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2024 January Intersession, and this constitutes **14.7% more** credits.
