As of the most recent available data (January 01, 2025), 4.0% fewer undergraduates have enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2024 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 7.3% fewer credits than they were at this time last year. There are 4.8% fewer undergraduates enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2024 January Intersession, and this constitutes 6.6% fewer credits.

As of the most recent available data (January 01, 2025), 27.0% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2024 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 25.9% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 16.3% more graduate students enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2024 January Intersession, and this constitutes 16.8% more credits.
