As of the most recent available data (January 02, 2025), 2.0% fewer undergraduates have enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2024 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 3.8% fewer credits than they were at this time last year. There are 1.9% fewer undergraduates enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2024 January Intersession, and this constitutes 2.5% fewer credits.

As of the most recent available data (January 02, 2025), 27.8% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2024 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 26.2% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 23.6% more graduate students enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2024 January Intersession, and this constitutes 23.5% more credits.
