As of the most recent available data (January 03, 2025), 2.5% fewer undergraduates have enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2024 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 4.4% fewer credits than they were at this time last year. There are 2.9% fewer undergraduates enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2024 January Intersession, and this constitutes 3.7% fewer credits.

As of the most recent available data (January 03, 2025), 26.1% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2024 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 24.1% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 22.3% more graduate students enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2024 January Intersession, and this constitutes 21.7% more credits.
