As of the most recent available data (January 06, 2025), 1.7% fewer undergraduates have enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 3.6% fewer credits than they were at this time last year. There are 2.8% fewer undergraduates enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2024 January Intersession, and this constitutes 3.5% fewer credits.

As of the most recent available data (January 06, 2025), 27.3% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2024 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 25.4% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 25.3% more graduate students enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2024 January Intersession, and this constitutes 24.7% more credits.
