As of the most recent available data (**January 07, 2025**), **4.9% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2024 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **8.0% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **5.9% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2024 January Intersession, and this constitutes **7.9% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**January 07, 2025**), **28.5% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2024 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **26.4% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **26.4% more** graduate students enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2024 January Intersession, and this constitutes **25.8% more** credits.
