As of the most recent available data (January 09, 2025), 4.7% fewer undergraduates have enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 7.5% fewer credits than they were at this time last year. There are 5.8% fewer undergraduates enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2024 January Intersession, and this constitutes 7.4% fewer credits.

As of the most recent available data (January 09, 2025), 29.0% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2024 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 27.2% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 26.9% more graduate students enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2024 January Intersession, and this constitutes 26.5% more credits.
