As of the most recent available data (January 20, 2025), 4.0% fewer undergraduates have enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 6.5% fewer credits than they were at this time last year. There are 5.2% fewer undergraduates enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2024 January Intersession, and this constitutes 6.5% fewer credits.

As of the most recent available data (January 20, 2025), 29.3% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2024 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 27.4% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 27.2% more graduate students enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2024 January Intersession, and this constitutes 26.7% more credits.
