As of the most recent available data (January 21, 2025), 3.9% fewer undergraduates have enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2024 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 6.4% fewer credits than they were at this time last year. There are 5.2% fewer undergraduates enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2024 January Intersession, and this constitutes 6.4% fewer credits.

As of the most recent available data (January 21, 2025), 29.2% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2024 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 27.7% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 27.4% more graduate students enrolled for the 2025 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2024 January Intersession, and this constitutes 27.0% more credits.
